On January 11th over 80 people were in attendance for a one day continuing legal education workshop for local officials on the Intersection between Environmental Justice and Local Land Use Planning and Zoning.

This program was organized by the National Academy of Public Administration and the Government Law Center at Albany Law School, with support from the Ford Foundation. It was sponsored and hosted by our Center for State and Local Government Law, UC Hastings.
